## Championship Singles Men \& Championship Singles Women

Knockout - 4 woods, 21 shots -
Men's singles open to all members identifying as male. Women's Singles open to all members identifying as female

## Championship Pairs

Knockout - 4 woods, 18 ends - open to all members.

## Handicap Singles

Knockout - 4 woods, 21 shots - difference in handicap to be put on lesser handicaps score before the start of play (e.g., If player ' $A$ ' has a handicap of 8 and player ' $B$ ' has a handicap of 3 , a difference of 5 . Player ' $A$ ' would start from 0 and player 'B’ from 5) - open to all members.

## Handicap Pairs (Drawn)

Knockout - 4 woods, 18 ends. Team member's handicap to be added together and the lower figure to be subtracted from the larger. The difference to be added to the lower handicapped teams score before start of play - open to all members.

## Veterans Handicap Singles

Knockout - 4 woods, 21 shots - difference in handicap to be put on lesser handicaps score before start of play (e.g. If player ' $A$ ' has a handicap of 8 and player ' $B$ ' has a handicap of 3 , a difference of 5 . Player ' $A$ ' would start from 0 and player ' $B$ ' from 5 ) - open to all members 70 years and over at the closing date for applications to the competition.

## Committee Singles

Knockout - 4 woods, 21 shots - open to current members of the Governing Committee and past members of the Governing Committee providing they have an unbroken membership of the Club.

## J D Smith

Knockout - 4 woods, 21 shots, - difference in handicap to be put on lesser handicaps score before start of play - open to all members who have never won a singles competition in this or any other club.

## Set Singles

Best of two sets, 9 ends each set - open to all members. If both sets are tied or each player wins one set, a third set of 3 ends will be played (all shots to count). If this set is tied one extra end will be played to determine the winner - open to all members.

## 2 Wood Singles

Knockout - to be played over 21 ends including final - open to all members.

## 2 Wood Drawn Pairs

Knockout - to be played over 18 ends - open to all members. Players seeded by handicap and drawn one from top and one from lower groups - open to all members.

## Spoon Games

The winner will be the player with the highest number of points at the end of season - qualification - participation in over $50 \%$ of Spoons games available - open to all members.

## Triples League (Drawn)

3 woods, 18 ends - open to all members. Teams are drawn based on ability taking into consideration the current club handicaps. All teams are to play each other twice on a league basis - open to all members.

## KO Handicap Triples

Knockout -2 woods, 18 ends, difference in handicap to be put on lesser handicaps score before the start of play (e.g. If team ' $A$ ' has a handicap of 8,6 and 7 and team ' $B$ ' has a handicap of 3,5 and 1 . Team ' $A$ ' handicap would be $8+6+7$ divided by $2=10.5$ rounded down to 10 and they would start from 0 being the higher handicapped team. Team ' B ' would have a handicap of $3+5+1$ divided by $2=4.5$ rounded down to 4 . Team ' $B$ ' would start from 6 , being the difference between the handicaps) - open to all members.

## KO Handicap Fours

Competition formats be agreed once numbers of entrants are known. Teams of 4 will be created by the competition committee based on player handicaps. Early stages of the competition will be based on mini leagues played over 7 ends. Each player will have 2 woods. KO stage will be the semi-finals and Final. - open to all members.

Aggregate League The winner will be the player who has amassed the highest number of shots in the matches played. Open to all members
