Our Club — is a comprehensive description of how our club works with sections introducing Key Committee Members and what their role at the club is.

The **Players A-H, I-P and Q-Z** gives a photo of each club playing member and a rundown of their achievements at Priory.

The **Shop** gives prices of club products – we hope to set up an online order and purchase page in the future.

Links to other sites – gives you the opportunity to look at lots of bowls related websites.



The Members Area – is a password protected area which contains all sorts of goodies which are just for us: Contact details, Ranking Points, AGM and Committee Minutes and lots more.



Calendar as you might guess is all about dates – It contains printable fixture lists – the clubs Google Calendar – Competition dates set for the year and forward planning for our indoor fixtures.

By far the most useful tool in this section is the chance to **book rinks** online with just an email.





Club News – is where you find out about significant events related to the club. We run our own fund raiser called the **50** Club – there is a draw once a month which can win you £75, £50 or £25 – this page is password protected. Club Honours gives you a sense of the clubs' achievements over the years. Club Champions records all our champions year on year and Archives gives you an even greater year by year account.

Matches is the area you will visit most often if you play competitively for Tarring Priory. The Match Selection Page allows you to put yourself forward to be selected for League, Cup and Friendly matches. You simply complete the online form, and your name can then be seen by the team managers, and they can pick their teams.

You can also see the **team selections** on-line by clicking on any of the pages – **WSBL**, **Stracey/Brodie**, **Cup**, **Friendly or Indoor** - The one different page here is the **Stracey/Brodie Leagues** – we allow the league to piggy-back our site and we produce league tables and fixtures for them.



All results of games and match reports can also be accessed by following the links in this section.



Club Comps – will be another well visited section – the **draw page** is a live update of all comps played at Priory in a season.

For the Historians amongst you the winners of comps dating back to the 30's are recorded in **Singles/ Pairs** and **Team Comps**. If you need to find out about the Monday Night Triples League follow the **Team Comps** link. For Spoons or Aggregate League info look in **Singles Leagues**

The last section of the website looks at bowls beyond our Club and provides a whole host of information about **County and National Bowls**. The section on **World Bowls** is well worth a read as it gives their view on bowling for those just starting out.
